CHALLENGES

Update gallery finished while the nationally accredited Muskegon Museum of Art remains open

Complete finish upgrades inside a tight timeline in order to accommodate scheduled exhibits.

Complete finish upgrades in as cost effective a manner as possible.

Complete finish upgrades without impacting sensitive HVAC systems.

RESULTS

Gallery finish upgrades have been completed in Cannon, Operhall and Wiener Galleries. A collaborative effort with museum staff and volunteers allowed for a seamless, efficient, and cost-effective transition of the galleries into new modern space allowing curators the ability to shape the space to better fit a specific exhibit. HVAC systems were isolated and shut down during various phases of the work to protect the system's integrity. Lighting use has been reduced as a result as well.
